Heather Verlee, 3443 Mahopac, stated she has grown up in the neighborhood since 1978 and then purchased her parents house and moved back. Ms. Verlee stated she has been there from the beginning of the association and is the current treasurer of the association, and she is really looking forward to seeing the SAD go through. Ms. Verlee stated that they need better road maintenance – not everybody is paying the same thing, and this is a great way to get everyone to pay to maintain the roads and to take care of the neighborhood, because it is our responsibility since we officially became an association in 2001. Ms. Verlee stated in her opinion, this is great for the neighborhood and great for everyone.
